TRUCK SHOW EVENT RULES



READ THESE RULES CAREFULLY – THEY APPLY TO EVERYONE

If you have any problems please contact a member of the show management and let us resolve it together. We hope you have a great time. These rules are intended to insure a safe, fair, fun filled show and must be adhered to by all participants and friends.

1. Show Management is the final authority.
2. All trucks must stay on the show area until the main show has ended.
3. All entries must be verifiable legal working trucks, licensed with a current safety inspection and registered to haul freight, unless entered in a non-working class.
4. When competing in a working class, the truck must be ready to turn the key and drive away. That means no jack stands and no loose pieces of stainless. Bumpers, spring cover and other “drop-on” pieces must be attached prior to your arrival on the show area and your truck must leave with the same equipment.
5. If deemed appropriate, show management reserves the right to adjust classes. Generally, there must be at least 3 entries to make a class.
6. To compete for WORKING TRUCK BEST OF SHOW the truck must be entered in one main class.
7. Once trucks are parked in the show area, no electric buffer may be used. Hand-polishing only. No running water hoses in the show area.
8. Tents and umbrellas are authorized as long as they do not block, hinder or infringe on your neighbors.
9. Any display around your truck should not extend out more than 2 feet on all sides.
10. All areas of the truck must be accessible to the judges.
11. Each truck must have a different competitor. The competitor must be present during the judging and must be accessible during the show hours.
12. This is a family event and depicts our industry to the public. Please, no profanity, sexually explicit or blatantly offensive graphics in the show area. Bring matter of anything questionable to the show management and we will decide if it should be covered. You will not have points deducted for covering it up. If you fail to bring it to our attention and the judges consider it offensive, you risk losing points.
13. **ALCOHOL POLICY:** NO outside alcohol is to be brought onto the premises. Should a competitor be deemed obviously inebriated, the competitor will automatically be disqualified by the judges.
14. Playing music is allowed only if it does not interfere with the enjoyment of others, or the management’s announcing.
15. No support vehicles will be allowed in the show area. No exceptions.
16. ENTRY FEES ARE **NON-REFUNDABLE**.
